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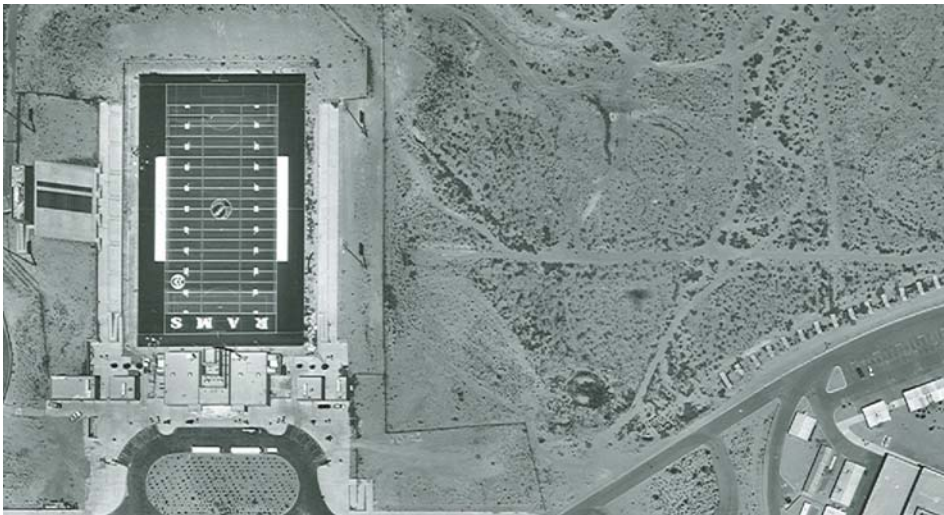

Executive Summary

The Problem

Not enough practice and playing fields for fall sports - boys football, boys soccer, girls soccer, cross country, girls volleyball.

Currently available practice fields

- ❖ Track Field (used by Football – 1 field)
- ❖ Large Practice area (used by Football – 3 fields)
- ❖ Small Practice area (used by Soccer – 1 field)

Current situation has three soccer teams sharing one field and the boys' varsity team transporting themselves to another school, reducing the effectiveness of practice sessions.

Eventually there will be additional high schools in Rio Rancho, with a need for District Facilities such as the Stadium to be shared by all schools.

Needed Fields for practice and competition:

- Football (4 practice fields for Varsity, JV & C-Teams & Stadium for games)
- Soccer (3 practice fields for Boys Varsity, JV, Girls Varsity, JV & Competition Field for games, 100 students in the Boys and Girls Soccer program)

The Solution

In the same fashion as the Baseball & Softball teams and booster clubs have built their own facilities, the Soccer teams and booster clubs through the Rams Soccer Foundation are implementing the following solution:

The phased funding and development of three new fields in the open space east of the stadium along with a field house for offices, lockers, equipment storage, ticket sales and concessions.

The entire RRHS Boys and Girls Soccer Program will be contained in this field complex and the current small practice area except the Boys C team (which will remain at the Mid-High) allowing the RRHS Soccer programs sufficient space to conduct effective practices, improve the quality and quantity of these programs in a highly competitive sport, and better provide a program that encourages academic excellence, teamwork and teaches life skills through excellent coaches, staff and facilities.

The Competition field will be used as a District Facility for Boys and Girls Varsity and other selected games by both programs as well as future Rio Rancho high schools.

The merging of new technologies (new breeds of grass, design of irrigation system, and usage of reclaimed water) will result in dramatically lower water and maintenance costs than the other fields at the High School. These technologies will create the safest, most environmentally friendly, durable and usable fields in the state if not the nation.


